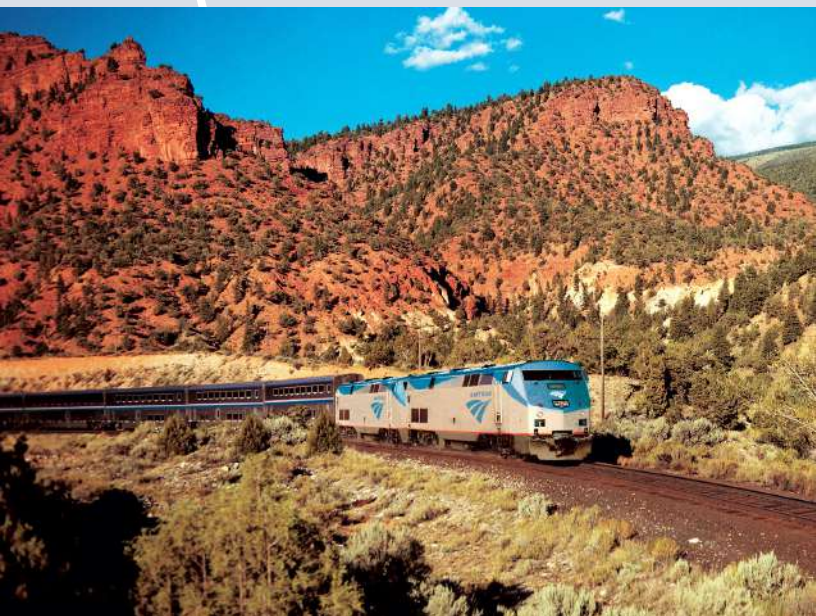

### Newton–Fort Worth Corridor

The Amtrak Connects US plan, setting the vision for Amtrak's expansion through 2035, includes the extension of the Heartland Flyer route to serve communities between Oklahoma City and Newton, allowing for a connection from the Southwest Chief to points in southern Kansas, Oklahoma, and Texas. Proposed stations include Wichita, Arkansas City, Ponca City, Perry, Guthrie, and Edmond. ### Service to Grand Canyon National Park

The Southwest Chief offers several travel opportunities for those wishing to visit Grand Canyon National Park. From Flagstaff, passengers can transfer to van shuttles provided by Groome Transportation, offering direct, twice-daily service to Williams, Tusayan, and the Grand Canyon (Maswik Lodge). During summer Groome Transportation provides three daily round trips. Passengers wishing to reach the park by rail can take connect to a Groome Transportation or Route 66 Express shuttle between the Flagstaff Amtrak station and the Grand Canyon Railway Depot and Hotel in Williams (by request to the driver), with daily departures on the Grand Canyon Railway each morning to the park and return trips in the afternoon. Passengers on Southwest Chief train 3 can stay overnight at the Grand Canyon Railway Hotel in downtown Williams before traveling to the park by train the following morning.
